OUR EFAW SYLLABUS

As per Appendix 6 of the new HSE Guidance (Edition 3, Oct 2013). On completion of training successful candidates should be able to:

- Understand the role of the first aider including the importance of preventing cross infection, the need for recording incidents and actions and use of available equipment.
- Assess the situation and circumstances in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency;
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious (including seizure).
- Administer Cardiopulmonary resuscitation CPR.
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is Choking.
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is Bleeding.
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is suffering from Shock.
- Provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries (including small cuts, grazes and bruises, minor burns and scalds, small splinters).
