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OUR FAW & FAWR SYLLABUS

As per Appendix 5 of the new HSE Guidance (Edition 3, Oct 2013). On completion of training, whether a full FAW course or a FAW requalification course, successful candidates should have satisfactorily demonstrated competence in all of the subject areas listed in Appendix 6 (please see our EFAW Syllabus) and also to be able to:

Administer first aid to a casualty with:

- Injuries to bones, muscles and joints, including suspected spinal injuries;
- Chest injuries;
- Burns and scalds;
- Eye injuries;
- Sudden poisoning;
- Anaphylactic shock

Recognise the presence of major illness and provide appropriate first aid to:

- Heart Attack
- Stroke
- Epilepsy
- Asthma
- Diabetes
